- Age Limit: 19 24 years (varies for different branches)
- **Gender:** Both Male & Female (for selected branches)
- Selection Process:

 - Final Merit List

 - Campus interview by Indian Navy officials
 - Shortlisting for SSB Interview
 - Medical Examination
 - Final Merit List

- 6 months at INA, Ezhimala
- Commissioned as Sub-Lieutenant

7. Special Naval Architect Entry Scheme (SNAES)

Eligibility Criteria:

- Educational Qualification: B.Tech/B.E in Naval Architecture
- Age Limit: 19 25 years
- Gender: Both Male & Female
- Selection Process:
 - Shortlisting based on academic performance
 - SSB Interview
 - Medical Examination
 - Final Merit List

8. NCC Special Entry (Naval Wing - Senior Division 'C' Certificate Holders)

- Educational Qualification: B.Sc/B.E/B.Tech with minimum 50% marks
- Age Limit: 19 24 years
- Gender: Both Male & Female
- Selection Process:
 - Direct SSB Interview (no written exam)
 - Medical Examination
 - Final Merit List

- 1 year at INA, Ezhimala
- Commissioned as Sub-Lieutenant

9. JAG Entry (Judge Advocate General) - Legal Branch

Eligibility Criteria:

- Educational Qualification: LLB (Law graduate with minimum 55%)
- Age Limit: 21 27 years
- Gender: Both Male & Female
- Selection Process:
 - Shortlisting based on marks
 - SSB Interview
 - Medical Examination
 - Final Merit List

Training:

- 6 months at INA, Ezhimala
- Commissioned as Sub-Lieutenant (Law Branch)

10. Permanent Commission (PC) & Short Service Commission (SSC)

- Permanent Commission (PC): Candidates serve in the Navy till retirement
- Short Service Commission (SSC): Candidates serve for 10 years (extendable to 14 years)

SSC is available through:

• INET, UES, NCC, and Direct Entries
