

CDS 2027 Application Process: Step-by-Step Guide for Aspirants

The **CDS 2027 application process** is the first important step for graduates who want to appear for the Combined Defence Services Examination conducted by UPSC. Candidates planning to join **IMA, INA, AFA or OTA** must complete the online application carefully and within the prescribed deadline.

For aspirants preparing with the **best CDS coaching in Kerala**, understanding the application process early can help avoid common mistakes and last-minute problems.

UPSC has introduced a new online application system in which candidates create an account, complete Universal Registration and fill the Common Application Form before applying for a specific examination.

CDS 2027 Application Process - Step-by-Step

Step 1: Check CDS 2027 Eligibility

Before starting the application, confirm that you satisfy the eligibility requirements.

Check:

- Age limit
- Educational qualification
- Nationality
- Gender eligibility
- Marital-status requirements
- Academy-specific eligibility

Candidates should particularly check the different requirements for **IMA, INA, AFA and OTA**.

Step 2: Create Your UPSC Account

Candidates need to use the new UPSC online application system.

The registration process includes creating an account and completing the required profile information. The new system allows candidates to keep common information ready before applying for a particular examination.

Make sure that your:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Father's name

- Mother's name
- Other personal details

are entered accurately.

Step 3: Complete Universal Registration

After creating the account, candidates need to complete their **Universal Registration**.

Enter the required personal and identification details carefully. Candidates are advised to keep an accepted photo identity document ready while completing the registration.

Using the same information consistently is important because incorrect personal details can create problems later.

Step 4: Complete the Common Application Form

The next stage is completing the **Common Application Form (CAF)**.

Candidates may need to provide information related to:

- Personal details
- Educational qualifications
- Address
- Identity information
- Other required details

Review every section carefully before proceeding.

Step 5: Select CDS 2027 Examination

Once the basic registration and common application details are completed, select the relevant **Combined Defence Services Examination 2027** application.

Choose the appropriate examination and carefully check the academy preferences available to you.

Candidates should select only those academies for which they satisfy the eligibility requirements.

Step 6: Enter Educational Qualification Details

Enter your graduation details exactly as required.

Depending on the academy, candidates may need to provide information regarding:

- Degree
- University
- Year of passing
- Registration/roll number where applicable
- Engineering qualification for INA, where required

Final-year students should provide details according to the instructions in the official notification.

Step 7: Upload Required Documents

Keep the required documents ready in the prescribed format and size.

Commonly required information/documents may include:

- Photograph
- Signature
- Photo identity document
- Educational details/documents
- Date-of-birth proof

The exact document requirements, file specifications and upload instructions should be checked in the **CDS 2027 notification** before submission.

Step 8: Pay the Application Fee

Candidates who are required to pay the examination fee should complete the payment using the payment methods permitted by UPSC.

Fee exemptions may apply to certain categories, so candidates should carefully check the notification before making payment.

Do not assume that payment alone completes the application. The complete application must be successfully submitted.

Step 9: Select Examination Centre

Candidates will be asked to provide their preferred examination centre from the available options.

Since examination centres can have limited capacity, candidates should complete the application as early as possible rather than waiting until the final day.

Step 10: Review the Entire Application

Before final submission, carefully verify every detail.

Check:

- Name and date of birth
- Educational qualification
- Academy preferences
- Examination centre
- Photograph and signature
- Identity-document details
- Category details, wherever applicable
- Contact information

A small error in the application can create unnecessary problems later.

Step 11: Submit the Application

After verifying all information, submit the completed CDS 2027 application.

Do not wait until the last few hours because heavy website traffic, payment issues or technical problems can cause unnecessary stress.

Save the application details and acknowledgement for future reference.

Common Mistakes to Avoid

While completing the CDS application, avoid:

- Entering an incorrect date of birth
- Using incorrect educational information
- Selecting an academy without checking eligibility

- Uploading unclear documents
- Ignoring photograph/signature specifications
- Waiting until the last day
- Forgetting to complete the final submission
- Failing to save application details

1. When will the CDS 2027 application form be released?

The application dates will be provided in the respective UPSC CDS 2027 examination notification. UPSC has published its Annual Calendar 2027, while candidates should

check the relevant CDS notification for the exact application schedule.

2. Can I apply for CDS 2027 online?

Yes. The CDS application is submitted online through the UPSC application system.

3. What documents are required for the CDS application?

Candidates should keep their photograph, signature, accepted photo ID and educational information/documents ready. Exact upload requirements should be checked in the CDS 2027 notification.

4. Can I apply for more than one academy?

Candidates can indicate academy preferences according to the options available in the application and their eligibility.

5. Can final-year students apply for CDS?

Eligible final-year students can apply subject to the conditions and deadlines specified in the official notification.

6. What happens after submitting the CDS application?

After successfully applying, candidates should begin focused preparation for the written examination. Candidates who qualify the written stage may proceed to the subsequent selection process, including SSB where applicable.

7. Is the CDS application fee compulsory for everyone?

No. Fee exemptions apply to certain categories. Candidates should check the fee and exemption rules in the applicable notification.

8. Can I correct my CDS application after submission?

Any correction facility and the period during which corrections are permitted will depend on the instructions issued for the particular examination. Candidates should review their application carefully before final submission.

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
