

# CDS 2027 Complete Preparation Guide for OTA, IMA, INA and AFA

The **CDS 2027 examination** is an important opportunity for graduates who aim to become commissioned officers in the Indian Armed Forces. Candidates can prepare for different academies through the Combined Defence Services examination, including **IMA, INA, AFA and OTA**.

## CDS 2027: Know Your Academy

### Indian Military Academy - IMA

IMA is for candidates aspiring to join the **Indian Army** through the relevant CDS entry.

The written examination includes:

- English
- General Knowledge
- Elementary Mathematics

### Indian Naval Academy - INA

INA is the entry for candidates aspiring to join the **Indian Navy**. Candidates should also check the applicable educational eligibility requirements.

The written examination includes:

- English
- General Knowledge
- Elementary Mathematics

### Air Force Academy - AFA

AFA is for candidates aiming to join the **Indian Air Force** through CDS.

The written examination includes:

- English
- General Knowledge
- Elementary Mathematics

Candidates should also be aware of the applicable Air Force selection and medical requirements.

## **Officers' Training Academy - OTA**

OTA is an important entry for candidates seeking Short Service Commission through CDS.

The written examination consists of:

- English
- General Knowledge

**There is no Mathematics paper for OTA.**

The written examination carries **300 marks for IMA, INA and AFA** and **200 marks for OTA**.

## **CDS 2027 Subject-Wise Preparation**

### **English Preparation**

Focus on:

- Grammar
- Vocabulary
- Synonyms and Antonyms
- Spotting Errors
- Sentence Improvement
- Idioms and Phrases
- Reading Comprehension
- Sentence Arrangement
- Fill in the Blanks

Practise English every day and maintain a vocabulary notebook for regular revision.

### **General Knowledge Preparation**

GK requires consistent preparation because of its broad syllabus.

Important areas include:

- Indian History
- Geography
- Indian Polity
- General Science
- Economics
- Defence
- Current Affairs

- Important national and international events

Focus on understanding important topics rather than trying to memorise unlimited information.

## **Mathematics Preparation**

IMA, INA and AFA aspirants should give Mathematics regular attention.

Important topics include:

- Number System
- Percentage
- Ratio and Proportion
- Profit and Loss
- Time and Work
- Time, Speed and Distance
- Algebra
- Geometry
- Mensuration
- Trigonometry
- Statistics

The Mathematics paper is broadly based on the **matriculation level**, making strong fundamentals particularly important.

## **CDS 2027 Preparation Strategy**

### **Phase 1 - Build the Foundation**

Start by understanding the syllabus and examination pattern. Strengthen your basics before moving to difficult questions.

### **Phase 2 - Complete the Syllabus**

Follow a subject-wise timetable and complete important topics systematically.

### **Phase 3 - Practise**

Solve topic-wise questions and previous-year CDS papers. This helps you understand question patterns and improve accuracy.

### **Phase 4 - Mock Tests**

Begin with sectional tests and gradually move towards full-length mock examinations.

After every test, analyse:

- Wrong answers

- Unattempted questions
- Time management
- Weak topics
- Repeated mistakes

## Phase 5 - Final Revision

Revise formulas, vocabulary, GK notes, Current Affairs and frequently tested concepts.

A simple daily schedule could be:

| Activity             | Time       |
|----------------------|------------|
| English              | 1 Hour     |
| Mathematics*         | 1.5 Hours  |
| GK & Current Affairs | 1.5 Hours  |
| Practice Questions   | 1 Hour     |
| Revision             | 30 Minutes |

\*For IMA, INA and AFA candidates. OTA aspirants can use this time for additional English and GK preparation.
