Follow major developments related to:

- Parliament and major legislation
- National awards
- Important appointments
- Government initiatives
- Important reports and surveys

3. International Affairs

Focus on important global developments involving India and major international organisations.

Study:

- India and neighbouring countries
- International summits
- International organisations
- Major global agreements
- Important international appointments
- Major geopolitical developments

4. Science and Technology

Important areas include:

- Space missions
- New technologies
- Defence technology
- Artificial Intelligence
- Biotechnology
- Scientific discoveries
- Major research developments

5. Sports, Awards and Important Events

Keep track of major:

- National and international sporting events
- Championships
- Awards
- Honours
- Books and authors
- Important personalities

Avoid spending too much time memorising minor details.

How Many Months of Current Affairs Should You Study?

A practical strategy is to prepare Current Affairs consistently throughout the year and give additional attention to the **months immediately preceding the examination**.

Instead of trying to study an entire year's news in the final few weeks, prepare monthly and revise regularly. This makes the large amount of information much easier to manage.

Best Daily Current Affairs Strategy

You don't need to spend several hours reading news every day.

A simple routine can be:

20-30 minutes: Read important Current Affairs

15 minutes: Make short notes

15 minutes: Revise previous topics

10-15 minutes: Solve Current Affairs MCQs

You can adjust this schedule according to your overall CDS preparation.

Make Short and Smart Notes

Don't copy complete news articles into your notebook.

For every important event, note:

What happened?

Where did it happen?

Who or which organisation was involved?

Why is it important?

What important fact should I remember?

Short notes make final revision much faster.

Follow the Learn-Revise-Test Method

An effective approach for CDS Current Affairs is:

Learn → Revise → Practise → Test → Analyse

After studying a month's Current Affairs:

1. Revise your notes.
2. Solve MCQs.
3. Identify incorrect answers.
4. Add important missed facts to your notes.
5. Revise them again during weekly study sessions.

Regular revision is essential because Current Affairs involves a large amount of information.

Use Previous-Year Questions

Previous-year CDS questions can help you understand the type and level of General Knowledge questions asked in the examination.

While practising, identify:

- Frequently tested areas
- Important themes
- Question difficulty
