

CDS 2027 General Knowledge Preparation: What Should You Study?

CDS 2027 GK Syllabus: What Should You Study?

A good preparation strategy should cover both **Static GK and Current Affairs**.

1. Indian History

History is an important area for CDS preparation. Focus on:

Maps and visual learning can make Geography easier to remember.

3. Indian Polity

Polity is an important part of CDS GK preparation.

Study:

- Constitution of India
- Fundamental Rights
- Fundamental Duties
- Directive Principles
- President and Vice-President
- Prime Minister and Council of Ministers
- Parliament
- Supreme Court
- High Courts
- Election Commission
- Constitutional and statutory bodies
- Local Government

Focus on understanding concepts rather than simply memorising facts.

4. General Science

Science questions generally cover fundamental concepts from Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Important areas include:

Physics: Motion, Force, Work, Energy, Electricity, Light and Sound.

Chemistry: Elements, Compounds, Acids, Bases, Metals and basic chemical reactions.

Biology: Human body, Diseases, Nutrition, Plants, Animals and basic Biology concepts.

NCERT-level fundamentals can be useful for building a strong foundation.

5. Indian Economy

You don't necessarily need to study advanced economics. Focus on basic concepts such as:

- National Income
- Inflation
- Banking
- Budget
- Taxation
- Monetary Policy

- Fiscal Policy
- Poverty and Unemployment
- Economic Development
- Government economic programmes

Understanding basic economic terms will make current economic news easier to follow.

6. Defence and Military Awareness

As CDS is a defence-related examination, aspirants should regularly follow important defence developments.

Focus on:

- Indian Armed Forces
- Defence organisations
- Military exercises
- Missiles and defence systems
- Important defence technology
- Major defence agreements
- Important military operations
- Ranks and commands
- Important defence appointments

Keep your preparation focused on relevant and significant developments rather than trying to memorise every defence-related news item.

Current Affairs for CDS 2027

Current Affairs should be prepared consistently throughout the year.

Pay attention to:

- National news
- International events
- Defence developments
- Government schemes
- Awards and honours
- Sports
- Important appointments
- Books and authors
- Science and technology
- Space missions
- Important reports and indices
- Summits and international organisations

How Much Current Affairs Should You Study?

Don't try to memorise every piece of news. Focus on **important events, their**

background and key facts.

Create short monthly notes and revise them regularly.

CDS GK Preparation Strategy

Follow the 3-Step Method

Learn → Revise → Practise

First understand the topic, then revise it and finally solve CDS-level questions.

Make Short Notes

Avoid writing lengthy notes. Prepare concise points, dates, names, facts and concepts that can be revised quickly.

Use Previous-Year Questions

Previous-year questions help you identify important areas and understand the type of GK questions asked in CDS.

Take Regular GK Tests

Weekly GK tests can help you identify your weak areas and improve your retention.

Daily CDS GK Study Plan

A beginner can dedicate around **1-1.5 hours daily** to GK.

30 minutes: Static GK

20 minutes: Current Affairs

20 minutes: Previous-year questions

20 minutes: Revision

Consistency is more important than studying a huge amount of GK in a single day.
