# CDS I 2026 - Eligibility, Age Limit, and Application Process Explained

#### Introduction

The Combined Defence Services (CDS) Examination is one of the most soughtafter defence exams conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC). It offers entry into the Indian Military Academy (IMA), Indian Naval Academy (INA), Air Force Academy (AFA), and Officer's Training Academy (OTA).

# CDS I 2026 Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility for CDS is divided into four major aspects: Nationality, Age & Marital Status, Educational Qualification, and Physical Standards.

#### 1. Nationality

Candidates must be:

- A citizen of India, OR
- A subject of Nepal/Bhutan, OR
- A Tibetan refugee who came to India before **January 1, 1962**, with the intention of permanently settling in India, OR
- A person of Indian origin who migrated from **Pakistan**, **Burma**, **Sri Lanka**, **or East African countries** with the intention of permanently settling in India.

☐ Candidates belonging to the last three categories must have **æertificate of eligibility** issued by the Government of India.

# 2. Age Limit and Marital Status (CDS I 2026)

The **age limits differ** for each academy:

- Indian Military Academy (IMA):
  - Age: **19-24 years** (Unmarried male candidates only).
- Indian Naval Academy (INA):

• Age: 19-24 years (Unmarried male candidates only).

#### • Air Force Academy (AFA):

- Age: 20-24 years as of January 1, 2027.
- Upper age limit is 26 years for candidates holding a valid and current Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL).
- Candidates must be unmarried.
- Officer's Training Academy (OTA Men):
  - Age: 19-25 years (Unmarried male candidates only).
- Officer's Training Academy (OTA Women):
  - Age: 19-25 years (Unmarried women, widows, or divorcees who have not remarried).

#### 3. Educational Qualification

- IMA & OTA: Graduation degree in any discipline from a recognized university.
- INA: Degree in Engineering from a recognized university or institution.
- **AFA**: Degree (with Physics and Mathematics at 10+2 level) or Bachelor of Engineering.

☐ Candidates appearing in the final year of their degree can also apply, provided they can submit proof of passing the exam by the time of SSB interview.

# 4. Physical Standards

- Candidates must be **physically fit** as per UPSC and Ministry of Defence guidelines.
- Key requirements:
  - Good mental and physical health.
  - No physical disabilities or chronic diseases.
  - Minimum acceptable height:
    - **Men** 157.5 cm (AFA 162.5 cm).
    - **Women (OTA)** 152 cm.

• Vision standards vary for each academy (corrected vision allowed).

☐☐ Candidates are advised to undergo a medical check-up before applying to avoid rejection at a later stage.

# **CDS I 2026 Application Process Explained**

The CDS I 2026 application form will be released online on the UPSC official website (www.upsc.gov.in). The process generally involves the following steps:

#### **Step 1: Online Registration**

- Visit the **UPSC website**.
- Click on "Apply Online for CDS I 2026" under the Examination tab.
- Registration is divided into Part I and Part II.

#### **Step 2: Part I Registration**

- Fill in personal details such as name, DOB, nationality, email ID, and mobile number.
- Select your **preferred academies** (IMA, INA, AFA, OTA).

### **Step 3: Part II Registration**

- Pay the application fee:
  - ₹200 for General and OBC candidates.
  - No fee for SC/ST candidates and female applicants.
- Upload scanned copies of passport-size photograph, signature, and photo ID proof.

# Step 4: Final Submission

- Preview the application form carefully.
- Submit and download the final application form.
- Keep a printed copy for future reference.

No. Only **unmarried men and women** (along with widows/divorcees who haven't remarried) are eligible for OTA.
