1. Build a Strong Daily Habit (Foundation Step)

What to Read Daily

- National & international news
- Editorials & opinion articles
- Legal and constitutional news

☐☐ **Daily time required:** 60–90 minutes

2. Focus on Issues, Not Isolated Facts

CLAT questions are **issue-based**.

For Every Current Affair, Learn:

- Background
- Why it is in the news
- Key stakeholders
- Legal/constitutional angle
- Impact & significance

☐☐ Example areas:

- New laws & bills
- Supreme Court judgments
- International treaties
- Elections & governance reforms

3. Monthly Compilation Strategy (MOST IMPORTANT)

Instead of daily notes, prepare **monthly CA notes**.

How to Make Monthly Notes

- 25-30 major issues per month
- 1 page per issue
- Include:
 - Key facts
 - Background
 - Legal angle
 - 2-3 MCQs (self-made)

☐☐ Monthly notes make revision easier.

HOW TO REVISE CURRENT AFFAIRS EFFECTIVELY

3-Level Revision Method

1. Daily quick reading
2. Monthly deep revision
3. Final 3-month rapid revision

Smart Revision Tools

- Short notes
- Mind maps
- Self-made quizzes
- Sectional tests

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

- ☐ Studying too many sources
- ☐ Memorizing facts without context
- ☐ Ignoring legal & constitutional angle
- ☐ No monthly revision
- ☐ Skipping mock analysis

SECTION-WISE TIME MANAGEMENT (CA & GK)

- Time per passage: **7-8 minutes**
- Attempt easier passages first
- Avoid overthinking factual options

- ✓ Focus on **“Why in news”**
- ✓ Link current issues with law
- ✓ Revise monthly, not randomly
- ✓ Practice comprehension-based CA passages

Q1. How many months of current affairs are required for CLAT 2027?

At least **12 months** before the exam.

Q2. Are static GK questions asked directly?

No. Static GK is tested **through current affairs passages**.

Q3. Is newspaper reading compulsory?

Yes. Editorial reading improves comprehension and issue understanding.

Q4. How much time should I give daily to CA & GK?

Minimum **1-1.5 hours daily**.
