1. Introduction (10-15%)

2. Body (70-75%)

- Case studies
- Data (sparingly)

- Vision for India
- Moral takeaway

What to Include

- ✓ Indian examples
- ✓ Administrative relevance
- ✓ Current affairs linkage
- ✓ Ethical values
- ✓ Interlinkages

What to Avoid

- Over-academics
- Extreme opinions
- Jargon overload
- Repetition

LANGUAGE & PRESENTATION STRATEGY

Language

- Simple, precise, dignified
- Short-to-medium sentences
- Neutral and balanced tone

Presentation

- Paragraph clarity
- Subtle underlining (very minimal)
- Clear transitions between ideas
