- **General Studies-III:** (250 marks) – Economy, Science & Tech, Environment,

Security

- **General Studies-IV:** (250 marks) – Ethics, Integrity, Aptitude
- **Optional Paper-I:** (250 marks)
- **Optional Paper-II:** (250 marks)

3. Personality Test (Interview)

Candidates who qualify for the mains examination are called for the Personality Test (Interview), carrying 275 marks. The interview assesses:

- Leadership qualities
- Logical reasoning and analytical skills
- General awareness and decision-making
- Ethical and moral integrity
