- **Differently abled (vision, hearing, speech impairment)**: 15 years
- **Orthopedically differently abled**: 10 years
- **Ex-Servicemen**: Relaxation up to service period + 5 years (maximum limit).

## 5. Is a degree necessary for appearing in the KAS exam?

Yes, a **bachelor's degree** (including professional courses) from a **UGC-recognized university** or a **National Institute established by the Government of India** is mandatory to apply for KAS.

## 6. Can I apply for KAS if I do not know Malayalam?

Yes, but candidates must be aware that **the Prelims exam includes a language proficiency test in Malayalam, Tamil, or Kannada**. Having a basic understanding of at least one of these languages is essential to clear the exam.

## 7. What are Stream-1, Stream-2, and Stream-3 posts

## in the KAS examination?
