List of GTO Tasks in NDA II 2026

1. Group Discussion (GD)

- Two topics are given (current affairs/social issues)
- No leader is assigned
- Tests:
 - Communication skills
 - Confidence
 - Clarity of thought

☐☐**Tip:** Speak with facts, not aggression. Be a contributor, not a dominator.

2. Group Planning Exercise (GPE) / Military Planning Exercise

- A situation-based problem is given
- Candidates write individual solutions and later discuss as a group

Tests:

- Logical thinking
- Planning ability

- Practical approach

3. Progressive Group Task (PGT)

- Group crosses obstacles using helping materials (planks, ropes, etc.)
- Difficulty increases progressively

Tests:

- Teamwork
- Resource utilization
- Leadership

4. Half Group Task (HGT)

- Similar to PGT but with a smaller group

□□ **Important:** More chances to speak and lead.

5. Individual Obstacles (IO)

- 10 obstacles to be completed in 3 minutes

Examples include:

- Jumping over walls
- Rope climbing
- Balance tasks

Scoring Pattern: Each obstacle carries marks (1 to 10)

6. Command Task

- You are made the leader
- You choose 2-3 subordinates
- Solve an obstacle

Tests:

- Leadership
- Decision-making
- Confidence

7. Lecturette

- You speak for 3 minutes on a topic
- 4 topics are given, choose one

Tests:

- Public speaking
 - Knowledge
 - Confidence
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8. Final Group Task (FGT)

- Similar to PGT
- Conducted at the end

□□ Focus: Team spirit and final impression

Key Officer Like Qualities (OLQs) Assessed

The GTO evaluates you based on these OLQs:

- Effective Intelligence
 - Reasoning Ability
 - Social Adaptability
 - Cooperation
 - Sense of Responsibility
 - Initiative
 - Self Confidence
 - Speed of Decision
 - Ability to Influence Group
 - Liveliness

- Practice speaking on current topics daily
 - Read newspapers like **The Hindu**
 - Participate in group discussions
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2. Build Physical Fitness

- Focus on:
 - Running (1-2 km daily)
 - Push-ups & pull-ups
 - Balance exercises
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3. Practice Group Tasks

- Join a coaching institute or practice with friends
 - Simulate PGT/HGT tasks
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4. Develop Leadership Skills

- Take initiative in group activities

- Help others without dominating

5. Stay Updated with Current Affairs

- Focus on:
 - Defence news
 - International relations
 - Social issues

6. Improve Logical Thinking

- Practice situation-based questions
- Solve reasoning puzzles
