Eligibility Criteria for CAPF Assistant Commandant

To apply for the UPSC CAPF AC exam, candidates must meet the following eligibility norms:

1. Nationality

- Must be a citizen of India
- Certain categories of Nepal/Bhutan citizens may apply under specific rules

2. Educational Qualification

• Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university

 Candidates awaiting final-year results may apply but must produce proof before final selection

3. Age Limit

- 20 to 25 years
- Age is calculated as of 1st August of the exam year

4. Physical Standards

To qualify, candidates must meet UPSC-prescribed physical requirements.

For Male Candidates

• Height: 165 cm

Chest: 81 cm (with 5 cm expansion)

• Weight: 50 kg

For Female Candidates

• Height: **157 cm**

• Weight: 46 kg

5. Physical Efficiency Test (PET)

Note: PET is qualifying in nature.

CAPF Assistant Commandant Selection Process

The CAPF exam is conducted in **four stages**:

1. Written Examination (Paper I + Paper II)

Conducted by UPSC

2. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) & Medical Standards

Conducted by CAPF forces

3. Interview / Personality Test

Conducted by UPSC

4. Final Merit List

Based on:

- Paper I Marks
- Paper II Marks
- Interview Marks

- 1. Visit **UPSC official website**
- 2. Register in One Time Registration (OTR)
- 3. Fill CAPF AC application form
- 4. Upload photo, signature, ID proof
- Pay fee (₹200 for General/OBC, exempt for SC/ST/Female)
- 6. Download application PDF

Effective Preparation Strategy

- Start with NCERTs for basics
- Read newspapers daily for current affairs
- Practice answer-writing for Paper II
- Attempt regular mock tests

- Maintain physical fitness for PET
- Follow a structured timetable

FAQs on CAPF Assistant Commandant

1. Who conducts the CAPF Assistant Commandant exam?

UPSC conducts the exam annually.

2. How many attempts are allowed?

There is no official attempt limit, only age limit applies.

3. Can women apply for CAPF AC?

Yes, women can apply for all forces except certain combat roles per force guidelines.

4. Is the CAPF AC exam tough?

It is moderately tough and competitive, similar to other UPSC exams.

5. Can final-year students apply?

Yes, but they must submit proof of graduation before the final selection.

6. What is the training period after selection?

Training generally lasts **1 year** at CAPF academies.

7. Is there negative marking in Paper I?

Yes, UPSC applies negative marking for wrong answers
