First develop conceptual clarity and then work on speed.

General Knowledge

Prepare:

- Indian History
- Geography
- Indian Polity
- General Science
- Economics
- Defence
- Current Affairs

GK requires regular revision because of the wide range of topics.

Step 4: Make the Most of Online Coaching
