There are multiple entry routes to join the Indian Army, Indian Navy, and Indian Air Force at an early stage. This guide covers all the ways to join the defense forces just after completing Class 12.

1. National Defence Academy (NDA) Entry Eligibility Criteria:

- Gender: Male candidates only (Female candidates can apply for the Indian Army through NDA from 2021 onward)
- Age: 16.5 to 19.5 years
- Education: 10+2 with Physics and Mathematics (for Air Force and Navy); any stream for Army
- Marital Status: Unmarried

Selection Process:

1. **Written Exam** (Conducted by UPSC)
 - Mathematics
 - General Ability Test (GAT)
2. **SSB Interview** (Services Selection Board)
3. **Medical Examination**

Training & Career Path:

Selected candidates undergo three years of training at the NDA in Pune, followed by

specialized training at respective academies:

- Indian Military Academy (IMA) for Army cadets
- Air Force Academy (AFA) for Air Force cadets
- Indian Naval Academy (INA) for Navy cadets

Upon successful completion, they are commissioned as officers in their respective services.

2. 10+2 Technical Entry Scheme (TES) - Indian Army Eligibility Criteria:

- Gender: Male candidates only
- Age: 16.5 to 19.5 years
- Education: 10+2 with a minimum of 60% in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM)
- Must have appeared for JEE Mains (Mandatory from 2021 onward)

Selection Process:

1. **Shortlisting based on JEE Mains Score**
2. **SSB Interview**
3. **Medical Examination**

Training & Career Path:

Selected candidates undergo a four-year technical training program at Officers Training Academy (OTA), Gaya, followed by a one-year training at IMA, Dehradun, before commissioning as a Lieutenant in the Indian Army.

3. 10+2 B.Tech Entry Scheme - Indian Navy Eligibility Criteria:

- Gender: Male candidates only
- Age: 16.5 to 19.5 years
- Education: 10+2 with at least 70% in PCM and 50% in English
- Must have appeared for JEE Mains (Mandatory)

Selection Process:

1. **Shortlisting based on JEE Mains Score**
2. **SSB Interview**
3. **Medical Examination**

Training & Career Path:

Selected candidates undergo a four-year B.Tech program at the Indian Naval Academy (INA), Ezhimala, and are commissioned as officers in the Indian Navy.

Aspirants who wish to join the Indian Armed Forces as officers immediately after the 12th standard have multiple pathways. The most prestigious route is through the NDA, followed by technical entries such as TES and 10+2 B.Tech entry schemes for Army and Navy, respectively.
