# India Creates History by Winning Gold at the Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025

India has achieved a historic milestone by securing its first-ever gold medal in the Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025, held in Patna. The Indian Men's Regu team clinched the title after a thrilling 2-1 victory over Japan in the finals, marking a significant achievement in the country's Sepak Takraw journey.

# Sepak Takraw World Cup 2025 Overview

The prestigious tournament was hosted by the Sepaktakraw Federation of India under the aegis of the International Sepaktakraw Federation (ISTAF) at the Patliputra Indoor Stadium, Kankarbagh, Patna, from March 20 to March 25, 2025. The event saw participation from 21 teams across multiple continents, including Asia, Europe, North America, and South America.

- Silver: Women's Doubles team (lost to Myanmar in the final)

Eight countries secured medals at the event. Thailand dominated the competition, finishing at the top with four medals, while India secured fourth place with seven medals.

## About Sepak Takraw

Sepak Takraw, a traditional sport originating in Malaysia, combines elements of football and volleyball and is commonly referred to as **kick volleyball** in India. The sport was introduced in India in the 1980s in Nagpur, Maharashtra.

The **Sepaktakraw Federation of India (SFI)** was established in 1982 alongside the Delhi Asian Games and serves as the governing body for the sport in India. Its headquarters are located in **New Delhi**.

The global governing body, the **International Sepaktakraw Federation (ISTAF)**, was also founded in 1982 and is headquartered in **Bangkok, Thailand**.
