- 11 pictures + 1 blank slide
- Write stories based on each image

2. WAT (Word Association Test)

- 60 words shown rapidly
- Write the first thought that comes to mind

3. SRT (Situation Reaction Test)

- 60 real-life situations
- Write your response

4. SD (Self Description Test)

- Write about yourself based on:
 - Parents' opinion
 - Teachers' opinion
 - Friends' opinion
 - Self-analysis

☐☐ These tests reveal your **true personality, not rehearsed answers**.

Day 3 & 4: GTO Tasks (Group Testing Officer Tasks)

These tasks evaluate your **behavior in a group**.

Indoor Tasks:

- Group Discussion (GD)
- Group Planning Exercise (GPE)
- Lecturette

Outdoor Tasks:

- Progressive Group Task (PGT)
- Half Group Task (HGT)
- Individual Obstacles
- Command Task
- Snake Race (Group Obstacle Race)

What is observed:

- Leadership
- Initiative
- Cooperation
- Problem-solving ability

Personal Interview (PI)

Conducted by the **Interviewing Officer (IO)**, usually on Day 2/3/4.

Questions based on:

- Personal background
- Education and academics
- Family details
- Hobbies and interests
- General knowledge
- Situational questions

Day 5: Conference (Final Decision Day)

- All assessors (Psychologist, GTO, IO) sit together
- Each candidate is called for **1-2 minutes**

Outcome:

- **Recommended**
- **Not Recommended**

SSB Marking System (How Selection Works)

Unlike written exams, SSB has **no fixed marks**.

Selection is based on:

- Consistency across all tests

- Initiative
- Self-confidence
- Ability to influence group

4. Dynamic Qualities

- Determination
 - Courage
 - Stamina

Common Mistakes Candidates Make

- ☐ Mugging up stories for TAT/WAT
- ☐ Speaking too much or too little in GD
- ☐ Lack of confidence
- ☐ Poor physical fitness
- ☐ Giving unrealistic answers
