6. **Optional Subject / Academic Background**

Most Common Interview Questions in CAPF Exam

1. Personal Background Questions

These are asked to know more about you as a person.

- Tell us about yourself.
- Why do you want to join CAPF?
- What qualities make you suitable for this role?
- How has your education shaped your personality?
- Who has been your role model in life and why?

2. Current Affairs and National Issues

These test your awareness of ongoing events.

- What is your opinion on the recent border security challenges?
- How can India tackle the issue of terrorism more effectively?
- What are your views on women's role in armed forces?
- How should CAPF handle internal security threats like Naxalism?
- What is your take on India's relations with neighboring countries?

3. Defence and Security Awareness

Since you are joining CAPF, the board will test your knowledge about the forces.

- Differentiate between BSF, CRPF, ITBP, CISF, and SSB.
- What are the major challenges faced by CAPF today?
- How does CAPF contribute to disaster management?
- What reforms do you suggest in CAPF training and structure?
- What is the role of CAPF in maintaining internal security?

4. Situational & Decision-Making Questions

These test your leadership and presence of mind.

- If your unit is ambushed, what steps will you take as a commander?

- How will you handle a communal riot situation?
- Suppose your team morale is low during a mission. What will you do?
- If you face corruption in your unit, how will you tackle it?
- How will you balance discipline with empathy while leading your troop?

5. Hobbies and Extracurricular Questions

These check whether you are honest and passionate about your interests.

- You mentioned cricket as your hobby. Who is your favorite player and why?
- Which books have you read recently? What did you learn from them?
- Do you think hobbies improve leadership qualities? How?
- Can your interest in music/sports be applied to CAPF leadership?

6. Academic / Optional Subject Questions

- Questions may be asked from your **graduation subject**.
- For example, if you studied **Economics**: “How does inflation affect security?”
- If your optional subject was **Geography**: “What are the geographical challenges in India’s border security?”
