- - 1. **Shortlisting:** Based on academic qualifications and NCC achievements.
 - 2. **SSB Interview:** Two-stage selection process:
 - Stage I: Officer Intelligence Rating (OIR) Test, Picture Perception & Description Test (PP&DT).
 - Stage II: Psychological Tests, Group Tasks, and Personal Interview.
 - 3. **Medical Examination:** Candidates qualifying Stage II undergo a thorough medical test.
 - 4. **Final Merit List:** Selection is based on overall performance in SSB and medical fitness.
