3. Educational Qualification

- For Army Wing of NDA: Candidates must have passed Class 12th (10+2) from a recognized board.
- For Air Force and Naval Wings of NDA & NA: Candidates must have passed Class 12th with Physics and Mathematics.

4. Marital Status

• Only unmarried male and female candidates are eligible to apply.

Selection Process

The NDA & NA (II) 2025 selection process consists of the following stages:

1. Written Examination

The exam consists of two papers:

- Mathematics (300 Marks) 2.5 hours
- General Ability Test (GAT) (600 Marks) 2.5 hours

The GAT is further divided into:

- English 200 Marks
- General Knowledge (Physics, Chemistry, General Science, History, Geography, and Current Affairs) – 400 Marks

2. SSB Interview

Candidates who qualify in the written exam will be called for the **Services Selection Board (SSB) Interview**, which includes psychological tests, group discussions, and physical & medical assessments.

3. Medical Examination

Candidates must meet the medical fitness standards prescribed by the armed forces.

How to Apply for NDA & NA (II) 2025?

Candidates can apply online through the **official UPSC website** (<u>www.upsc.gov.in</u>) by following these steps:

- 1. Visit the official UPSC website.
- 2. Click on the NDA & NA (II) 2025 notification link.
- 3. Register by filling in personal details.
- 4. Upload the required documents (photo, signature, and ID proof).
- 5. Pay the application fee online.
- 6. Submit the form and take a printout for future reference.

Application Fee

- General/OBC Candidates: ₹100
- SC/ST/Female Candidates: Exempted from the fee

Admit Card Release

The admit card will be released **three weeks before the exam** on the official UPSC website. Candidates must download and print their admit cards to appear for the exam.

Exam Centers in Kerala

The NDA exam is conducted at various centers across India. In **Kerala**, the exam centers are:

- Thiruvananthapuram
- Kochi

• Kozhikode

Candidates must choose their preferred exam center while filling out the application form.
