- Bank account passbook
- Address proof (Ration card or self-declaration in PMUY 2.0)
- Passport-size photo

How to Apply for PM Ujjwala Yojana

- 1. Visit the nearest LPG distributor (Indane, Bharat Gas, or HP Gas)
- 2. Collect or download the PMUY application form
- 3. Fill in details and attach necessary documents
- 4. Submit the form to the distributor
