1. Important Dates

• Notification Date: 5th March 2025

• Last Date for Application: 25th March 2025 (till 18:00 hrs)

2. Application Process

Apply only online via UPSC Website

- One Time Registration (OTR) is mandatory before filling the application
- Upload a valid Photo ID (Aadhaar, PAN, Passport, etc.)

3. Eligibility Criteria

- Nationality: Indian citizens; subjects of Nepal & Bhutan can apply with government approval
- Age Limit:
 - 20–25 years as of 1st August 2025 (born between 2nd August 2000 1st August 2005)
 - Age relaxations:

SC/ST: 5 yearsOBC: 3 years

■ Ex-Servicemen/Central Govt. Servants: 5 years

- Education: Bachelor's degree from a recognized university
- Physical Standards: Minimum height of 165 cm (men) & 157 cm (women);
 specific medical requirements

4. Exam Pattern

- Paper 1: General Ability & Intelligence (250 marks, objective-type, bilingual)
- Paper 2: General Studies, Essay & Comprehension (200 marks)
- Physical Efficiency Test (PET): Includes running, long jump, and shot put
- Medical Standards Test
- Interview/Personality Test: 150 marks

5. Vacancies (Tentative)

Total: 357 vacancies across forces:

BSF: 24CRPF: 204CISF: 92ITBP: 04

- SSB: 33
- 10% vacancies reserved for Ex-Servicemen

6. Application Fee

- ₹200 (except SC/ST/Female candidates, who are exempted)
- Payment modes: Debit/Credit Card, UPI, Net Banking, SBI Challan

7. Selection & Final Merit List

- Based on Written Exam, Physical Tests, and Interview
- Service Allocation depends on rank and preference

8. Other Key Rules

- **Negative Marking**: 1/3rd marks deducted for wrong answers in Paper 1
- Admit Card: Available online only, no postal dispatch
- Banned Items: Mobile phones, smartwatches, Bluetooth devices, etc.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) - CAPF (Assistant Commandants) 2025

1. What is the CAPF (Assistant Commandant) exam?

The CAPF (AC) exam is conducted by **UPSC** to recruit **Assistant Commandants** (**Group A Officers**) in various **Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF)** such as BSF, CRPF, CISF, ITBP, and SSB.

2. What is the last date to apply for CAPF 2025?

The last date to apply online is 25th March 2025 (till 6:00 PM).

3. When is the CAPF (AC) 2025 exam?

The written exam will be conducted on **3rd August 2025.**

4. How many vacancies are available?

A total of 357 vacancies have been announced for CAPF (AC) 2025:

BSF: 24CRPF: 204CISF: 92ITBP: 4SSB: 33

5. What is the salary for CAPF Assistant Commandants?

The salary is based on Pay Level-10 (Rs. 56,100 - 1,77,500) with additional

allowances.

6. What is the age limit for CAPF (AC) 2025?

• Minimum: **20 years**

• Maximum: 25 years (Born between 2nd August 2000 and 1st August 2005)

7. Is there any age relaxation?

SC/ST: 5 yearsOBC: 3 years

• Civilian Central Government Employees & Ex-Servicemen: 5 years

8. What is the educational qualification required?

Candidates must have a **Bachelor's Degree** from a recognized university.

9. Can final-year students apply?

Yes, final-year students can apply, but they must produce proof of passing before the Physical Tests.

10. What is the selection process for CAPF (AC)?

The selection process consists of:

- 1. Written Exam (Objective & Descriptive)
- 2. Physical Standards Test (PST) & Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
- 3. Medical Examination
- 4. Interview/Personality Test
- 5. Final Merit List based on Written + Interview Marks

11. What is the exam pattern for CAPF (AC) 2025?

- Paper 1 (Objective): General Ability & Intelligence 250 marks
- Paper 2 (Descriptive): General Studies, Essay, and Comprehension 200 marks

12. Is there negative marking in the CAPF exam?

Yes, 1/3rd of the marks will be deducted for each wrong answer in Paper 1 (Objective Type).

13. What are the physical requirements for CAPF (AC)?

• Height: Male - 165 cm, Female - 157 cm

Chest (Men): 81 cm (with 5 cm expansion)

• Weight: Male - 50 kg, Female - 46 kg

14. What are the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) requirements?

- 100m Race: Male 16 sec, Female 18 sec
- 800m Race: Male 3 min 45 sec, Female 4 min 45 sec
- Long Jump: Male 3.5m, Female 3.0m (3 chances)
- Shot Put (Men only): 4.5m (3 chances)

15. Can pregnant women appear for the Physical Test?

No, pregnant women will be **declared temporarily unfit** and tested **six weeks after delivery.**

16. What is the interview process?

Candidates who qualify the **Written & Physical Tests** will be called for an **Interview/Personality Test** carrying **150 marks**.

17. How can I apply for the CAPF 2025 exam?

- Visit https://upsconline.gov.in
- Complete One-Time Registration (OTR)
- Fill out the online application form
- Upload required documents and submit before 25th March 2025

18. What is the application fee?

- General/OBC/EWS: Rs. 200
- SC/ST/Female candidates: Exempted (No Fee)

19. Can I edit my application after submission?

Yes, candidates can **modify their application** from **26th March to 1st April 2025**. However, some details like **name**, **date of birth**, **and parent details cannot be changed**.

20. Can I withdraw my application after submission?

No, once submitted, applications cannot be withdrawn.

21. Where will the CAPF exam be conducted?

The exam will be held at various centers across India. Allocation is based on a first-apply-first-allot basis.

22. How will I receive my admit card?

Admit cards will be available on **UPSC's website** one week before the exam. No physical admit card will be sent by post.

23. Can I use a mobile phone or calculator in the exam hall?

No, mobile phones, smartwatches, calculators, or any electronic devices are

strictly prohibited.

24. What documents do I need for the CAPF application?

- Photo ID proof (Aadhaar, Voter ID, PAN, Passport, Driving License)
- Educational Certificates
- Caste Certificate (for reserved categories)
- Ex-Servicemen Certificate (if applicable)

25. Is there any reservation for ex-servicemen?

Yes, 10% of total vacancies are reserved for ex-servicemen.

26. When will the final result be announced?

The final merit list will be published after the Interview/Personality Test in early 2026.

27. What happens after selection?

Selected candidates will undergo **training at different CAPF academies** before being posted as Assistant Commandants.
