- **Next 50 minutes:** Move to Geometry, Trigonometry, and Mensuration. These require more time but carry high weightage.
- **Final 40 minutes:** Handle Algebra and Statistics.

☐☐*Tip:* Don't spend more than **2 minutes** on a single math problem. Mark doubtful ones and revisit if time remains.

General Time Management Strategies

1. **Divide and Conquer** – Break 120 minutes into smaller time blocks per section.
2. **Use Rounds Strategy**
