

TIME MANAGEMENT TIPS FOR NEET 2026 EXAM DAY

Section	Questions to Attempt	Suggested Time
Biology (Bot + Zoo)	90	85-90 minutes
Chemistry	45	45-50 minutes
Physics	45	50-55 minutes
Total	180	180 minutes

☐☐ Biology should be completed faster to save time for Physics.

BEST TIME MANAGEMENT STRATEGY FOR NEET 2026 EXAM DAY

1. Fix Your Subject Order in Advance

Never decide subject order in the exam hall.

Recommended Orders

- Biology → Chemistry → Physics (most popular)

- Chemistry → Biology → Physics (for strong Chem students)

☐☐ Start with your **strongest subject** to build confidence.

2. Use the 3-Round Question Attempt Strategy

Round 1: Easy Questions

- Attempt only sure-shot questions
- No calculations, no doubts
- Fast and confident

Round 2: Moderate Questions

- Slight calculations or thinking
- Time-controlled attempts

Round 3: Difficult/Doubtful Questions

- Attempt only if confident
- Avoid guesswork

☐☐ This prevents time waste on tough questions early.

3. Ideal Time per Question (Golden Rule)

Subject	Time per Question
Biology	40-50 seconds
Chemistry	~1 minute
Physics	1-1.2 minutes

☐☐ If a question exceeds this time **skip and move on**.

4. Biology Time Management Tips (360 Marks Section)

- Read questions carefully
- Watch for words like *NOT, EXCEPT, INCORRECT*
- Stick strictly to NCERT

- Avoid overthinking simple facts

☐☐ Aim to finish Biology in **≤90 minutes**.

5. Chemistry Time Management Tips

Inorganic Chemistry

- Direct NCERT questions
- Attempt quickly

Organic Chemistry

- Reaction-based logic
- Skip if mechanism is unclear

Physical Chemistry

- Formula-based numericals
- Avoid lengthy calculations

☐☐ Do not get stuck on one numerical.

6. Physics Time Management Tips (Most Time-Consuming)

- Identify easy formula-based questions
- Skip lengthy numericals initially
- Use approximation when possible

☐☐ Attempt **easy & moderate Physics questions first**.

7. Smart Question Selection Technique

- Target **155-165 confident attempts**
- Accuracy above **85%**
- Avoid blind guessing

☐☐ Fewer correct attempts with high accuracy > many risky attempts.

8. How to Use On-Screen Timer Effectively

- Check time only at subject switches
 - Avoid checking timer after every question
 - Trust your practice rhythm
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9. Handling Panic During the Exam

If you feel stressed:

- Take 3 deep breaths
- Move to easier questions
- Remind yourself: *"I've practiced this."*

☐☐ Panic wastes more time than tough questions.

10. Last 15 Minutes Strategy

- Review marked questions
- Check OMR selections carefully
- Avoid changing answers unnecessarily

☐☐ Change answers only if you are **100% sure**.

MOST COMMON TIME MANAGEMENT MISTAKES IN NEET

- ☐ Spending too long on tough Physics questions
 - ☐ Rereading questions multiple times
 - ☐ Guessing too many questions
 - ☐ Changing subject order randomly
 - ☐ Overchecking answers
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TOPPER-APPROVED NEET EXAM DAY TIME MANAGEMENT TIPS

- ✓ Practice full mocks with exact timing
- ✓ Follow the same strategy in every mock
- ✓ Keep accuracy above speed
- ✓ Stay calm and focused

☐☐ **NEET rewards calm minds and smart decisions, not rushed attempts.**

EXAM DAY DO'S & DON'Ts (TIME-WISE)

DO

- ✓ Attempt easy questions first
- ✓ Keep track of subject-wise time
- ✓ Read questions carefully

DON'T

- ☐ Get stuck on one question
 - ☐ Panic due to one tough section
 - ☐ Overthink Biology questions
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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1. How much time should I give to Biology in NEET?

Around **85-90 minutes**.

Q2. Should I attempt all 180 questions?

Only if accuracy is high; otherwise skip doubtful ones.

Q3. Is it okay to leave tough Physics questions?

Yes. Focus on easy and moderate questions first.

Q4. How can I improve exam-day time management?

By practicing full-length mock tests regularly.

Q5. What if I run short of time in the last section?

Attempt only sure-shot questions and avoid guessing.

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
