MASTER TIME MANAGEMENT STRATEGY FOR CLAT 2027

1. Follow Section Order Strategy

Start with sections where:

- ✓ Accuracy is high
- ✓ Confidence is strong
- ✓ Time consumption is lower

□□ Many toppers start with English or Legal Reasoning.

2. The 3-Round Attempt Method

Round 1 - Easy Questions

- Attempt direct and easy questions
- Build confidence

Round 2 - Moderate Questions

- Solve reasoning-based questions

Round 3 - Tough Questions

- Attempt only if time remains

□□ Maximizes attempts with accuracy.

3. Passage Time Control Strategy

Ideal Time Per Passage:

- Read passage → 2-3 min
- Solve questions → 3-4 min

□□ Total → 6-7 min per passage.

4. The Smart Skipping Rule

If stuck:

- Skip after 40-50 seconds
- Return later if time allows

□□ Don't get emotionally attached to questions.

5. Accuracy vs Attempts Balance

Safe Attempt Strategy:

- Attempt 85-95 questions
- Maintain high accuracy

□□ High accuracy = Higher net score.

SECTION-WISE TIME MANAGEMENT TIPS

English Language

- ✓ Read questions before passage
 - ✓ Avoid rereading full passage
 - ✓ Focus on tone and main idea
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Current Affairs & GK

- ✓ Attempt only known questions
- ✓ Avoid guessing too much
- ✓ Finish quickly

□□ GK is score booster if done fast.

Legal Reasoning

- ✓ Identify principle first
 - ✓ Avoid personal opinion
 - ✓ Focus on passage logic
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Logical Reasoning

- ✓ Find conclusion quickly
 - ✓ Eliminate extreme options
 - ✓ Focus on argument structure
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Quantitative Techniques

- ✓ Attempt only sure questions
 - ✓ Don't waste time on tough DI sets
 - ✓ Revise formulas regularly
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TIME MANAGEMENT DURING CLAT PREPARATION

Daily Time Management Rule

Study Distribution:

- Reading Practice → 2 hours
 - Concepts + Practice → 3 hours
 - Mock Test / Analysis → 2 hours
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Weekly Time Management Rule

- ✓ 2-3 Full Mocks
- ✓ 2 Sectional Tests
- ✓ 1 Full Revision Day

MOCK TEST TIME MANAGEMENT PRACTICE

Practice:

- Fixed section timing
- Real exam simulation
- Timer-based sectional practice

□ Mock tests are best time training tools.

LAST 30 DAYS TIME MANAGEMENT PLAN

- ✓ Attempt 3-4 mocks weekly
- ✓ Practice section timing strictly
- ✓ Focus on accuracy improvement

EXAM DAY TIME MANAGEMENT GOLDEN RULES

- Don't panic if one section is tough
- Stick to planned section timing
- Don't overspend time on Quant
- Keep last 5 minutes for review

COMMON TIME MANAGEMENT MISTAKES

- Spending too much time on one passage
- Attempting all questions blindly
- Ignoring mock test timing practice
- Starting with weakest section

TOPPER TIME MANAGEMENT HABITS

- ✓ Attempt mocks at same exam time daily
- ✓ Track time per section
- ✓ Maintain attempt vs accuracy record
- ✓ Follow fixed section order

IDEAL ATTEMPT STRATEGY FOR HIGH SCORE

Accuracy	Safe Attempts	Expected Score Range
95%	85-90	Very High Rank
90%	90-95	High Rank
85%	95-100	Good Rank

FINAL SUCCESS FORMULA

Speed + Accuracy + Smart Section Order + Mock Practice = Maximum CLAT Score

Q1. How many questions should I attempt in CLAT 2027?

Around 85-95 with good accuracy is safe.
