TROPEX-25: Indian Navy's Largest Maritime Exercise Strengthens Joint Combat Readiness in the Indian Ocean

Comprehensive Phases of TROPEX-25

TROPEX-25 is structured into multiple phases, both in harbor and at sea, encompassing:

- **Combat Operations:** Simulated high-intensity naval warfare scenarios to test and enhance combat readiness.
- **Cyber and Electronic Warfare Operations:** Assessing resilience and response strategies against cyber threats and electronic warfare tactics.
- Live Weapon Firings: Real-time deployment of weaponry to validate operational effectiveness.
- **Amphibious Exercise (AMPHEX):** Coordinated land-sea operations to demonstrate and refine amphibious assault capabilities.

Scale of Participation

The exercise witnesses an impressive assembly of assets:

- Naval Fleet: Approximately 65 Indian Naval ships and 9 submarines.
- Aviation Assets: Over 80 aircraft of various types, including the indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant, Visakhapatnam and Kolkata-class destroyers, and Kalvari-class submarines.
- **Air Wing:** MiG-29K fighters, P-8I maritime patrol aircraft, HALE Sea Guardian drones, and MH-60R helicopters.

This extensive mobilization underscores the Navy's commitment to maintaining a high state of operational readiness.

Joint Integration with Sister Services

Emphasizing the essence of jointness, TROPEX-25 integrates assets from the Indian Army, Indian Air Force (IAF), and the Indian Coast Guard:

- Indian Army: Deployment of an Infantry Brigade comprising over 600 troops.
- **Indian Air Force:** Participation of aircraft such as Sukhoi-30s, Jaguars, C-130s, flight refuellers, and AWACS.
- Indian Coast Guard: Involvement of more than 10 ships and multiple aircraft.

This tri-service synergy ensures a cohesive and unified approach to maritime security.
