CAPF stands for Central Armed Police Forces, a group of five paramilitary forces under the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA).

They are responsible for border protection, internal security, counter-insurgency, VIP security, and assisting the State Police during law-and-order situations.

However, officially only BSF, CRPF, CISF, ITBP & SSB are categorized as CAPF.
