1. BSc Nursing (MNS) Through NEET UG

- For 12th passed students to undergo four years of military nursing training.

2. Short Service Commission (SSC)

- For candidates who have already completed **BSc Nursing / Post Basic BSc Nursing / MSc Nursing**.

Eligibility Criteria for MNS

Educational Qualification

- 10+2 with **Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English**
- Minimum **50% aggregate**
- For SSC: BSc Nursing / Post Basic BSc Nursing / MSc Nursing from a recognised institute

Age Limit

- BSc Nursing (MNS): **17 to 25 years**
- SSC: Up to **35 years**

Gender

- Only **Female Candidates** are eligible

Marital Status

- Both **unmarried and married** candidates are eligible (conditions apply)

Nationality

- Indian Citizen

Medical Standards

- Must meet Armed Forces medical fitness standards
